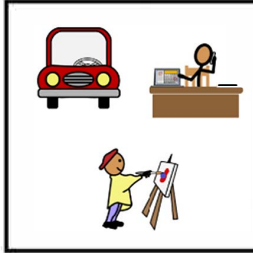
Getting Ready:

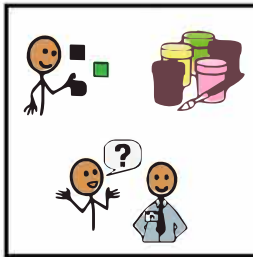
Arriving at You're Fired:

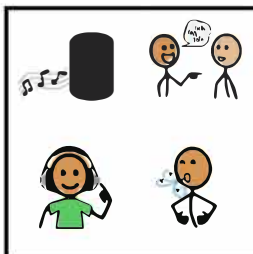
Creating My Artwork:

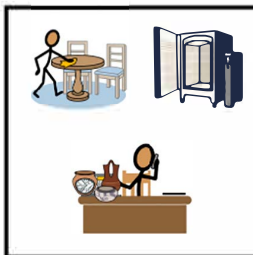
Sensory Tips:

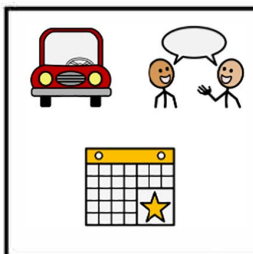
Finishing My Artwork:
